Rules of the off-leash area:

- Open from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Up to date rabies and licence tags required
- Use the off-leash area at your own risk
- Leash your dog while entering and exiting
- Keep your dog within sight and under verbal control
- Clean up after your dog
- Do not allow your dog to chase wildlife
- No puppies under 4 months, female dogs in heat, sick dogs, aggressive dogs or dogs required to be muzzled
- No glass containers food or toys
- Children must be supervised by an adult
- Off-leash area users are subject to the *Dog Owners Liability Act*
